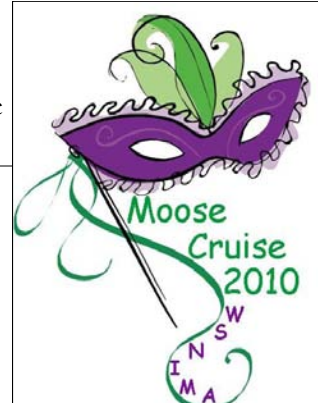
## HAVE YOU PURCHASED YOUR ASSOCIATION RAFFLE TICKETS YET?
